

## GCHS MTSS

GCHS uses the Comprehensive Student Plan (CSP) to help teachers gauge student mastery of standards and skills, think critically about their instruction and provide student feedback. Students and teachers use the CSP to track progress and set goals. The CSP includes a variety of data points and is used to document interventions as well. The CSP can be reviewed and discussed with parents. The CSP may also serve as a student's Personalized Education Plan.

### School-wide Interventions

Overtime is a daily 30 minute remediation/enrichment period. During overtime, teachers can provide whole class, small group or individual academic support. Students not needing this support work on projects, performance events or enrichment activities.

All departments provide after-school tutoring. Teachers schedule this time with students. Bus service is available to take students home after tutoring

Foundations classes in math and English/Language Arts are provided for students who need to further develop foundational skills before beginning high school math and language arts courses.

GCHS also provides READ 180 classes for students who are not yet reading on grade level. This course provides students with strategies and skills for improving their reading and comprehension levels through individualized instruction.
